

# Norton Garden & Amistad Apartments Construction Update

These snapshots highlight exciting new developments in the Norton Garden Building and preparations for the new Pitzer Lodge/Amistad Apartment Building.



## Phase I Construction

The afternoon shade covers the old Plymouth Road, now being used as a construction staging area. This photo of the Norton Garden Building was taken from the second floor of New Merritt, looking north toward the snow-covered mountains. First floor apartments are to the left and administrative offices are to the right.



You can see that the first floor framing is complete and carpenters are beginning construction on the second floor! In the center of this photo is the balcony support for Norton Garden Apartment 204. Beneath it, a patio will be poured for Apartment 104.



The photos to the left and below show Norton Garden Apartments 101 and 201. This is the western side of the building.





## Phase II Begins!

Brooks Court is taken down, starting with the roof. Many of the materials were separated for reuse or recycling.
